Dear Mr. Lutz:

The Mare Island Naval Shipyard facility Number 44 is hereby requesting the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) to cancel the existing Permits to Operate the facility's chrome plating and anodizing tanks, S-436, S-437, S-439, S-440, and S-441, located in Building 225 since plating operations at this facility are not anticipated in the foreseeable future. The Shipyard's decision to cancel the above Permits is aimed merely at reducing the Total Score (TS) for the final prioritization ranking. The workload and mission of the Shipyard and the availability of high quality chrome plating in the future may require applicability for new permits.

In addition to the above adjustment, enclosed are the completed BAAQMD Dispersion Factor Forms contributing further in bringing the final TS under unity for both, carcinogens and noncarcinogens.
