- 1. Per enclosure (1), Mare Island Naval Shipyard (NAVSHIPYD MARE) ceased electroplating work in Building 225 during August 1988. Since that time, the following has occurred:
- a. As an Installation Restoration (IR) site, the facility and area around it have been surveyed to determine the extent of contamination. Still pending completion is the "remediation" phase of the cleanup study.
- b. NAYSHIPYD MARE has arranged for most of its electroplating workload to be performed by other Department of Defense facilities. The cost and performance of the service obtained has been satisfactory.
- c. The air emission permits required to operate various exhaust systems have expired. Up to two years and the expense of new exhaust equipment would be required to obtain new permits.
- d. A contract has been initiated to remove and dispose of the plating solutions which still remain in the facility.
- e. NAVSHIPYD MARE has determined that it would not be cost effective to attempt to reopen the Building 225 facility.
- 2. This letter provides notification that NAVSHIPYD MARE will permanently close the Electroplating Facility, Building 225.
