This special report is being written to you pursuant to paragraph II.A.3
of the Consent Decree between the State of California and Mare Island Naval
Shipyard.

The following suspected violation was confirmed as a potential Class I viola-
tion by Mare Island Naval Shipyard's Environmental-Energy Management Division
on February 19, 1988. Oral notification of this violation and intended
corrective action was given to Mr. Ed Refsell of the DHS by Dr. William
Cornils on February 22, 1988.

Violation: Release of chronic acid mist from a scrubber onto the building
walls adjacent to the scrubber.

Corrective action(s) taken: Cleaned the released material off the walls.
